

Elementary Online Learning FQA

1. My student is an elementary aged student. How does the online program work for elementary students?

Elementary students will be assigned classes in the four content areas, as well as in a “special” area such as Art. Students will log on to a pre-recorded lesson in each content area where they will be guided by a pre-recorded lesson by a certified teacher. Students will complete the assignments (online and workbooks will be provided for students for additional practice, as well) and they will automatically submit the assignments to the online teacher. This teacher will correct the assignment and provide feedback to the student and parent. Other assignments, such as assessments, will be graded immediately and provide instant feedback to the student/parent.

2. Is there a special time my child will need to log in each day? My work schedule varies and we can't always log in at the same time each day?

No. You may log in when you are able. It does not matter if it is early in the morning or in the evening. The lesson is the same. Parents and students will be provided with a suggested pacing guide so that satisfactory progress is being maintained throughout the semester. A child could, however, do extra on any day if they knew there would be a day they could not log on and complete assignments and wanted to work ahead.

3. Will there be things I need to print off?

No. Workbooks and printed materials are provided to you at no cost. There is not anything that you will need to print off.

4. Will I need internet?

Yes, the internet will be required to access the lessons and submitting the required assignments.

5. Will my child get a grade?

Yes, your child's performance will be continually updated and you will have an accurate, up to the minute idea of how your child is performing.

6. What if my child has special needs?

Students with an IEP will be able to have one of our district's special education teachers tailor the lessons to them as a means of accommodating the work for them. Every effort will be made to maintain accommodations that can be maintained through a virtual lesson. Obviously, some accommodations that require face to face interaction will not be possible, but just like in face to face school we will honor your child's unique learning needs.
