Grades 6-12 Online Learning Frequently Asked Questions

1. My student is a Middle/High school student. How does the online program work for secondary students?

Students in the Middle School will be assigned classes comparable to the classes that students in the face to face learning will take. Along with the four core content areas (Math, English, Science, and Social Studies) students will be assigned two electives. Students in high school will be assigned corresponding classes compared to what their schedule would have been if they were to attend the face to face learning. This scheduling will be done by the high school.

2. Is there a special time my child will need to log in each day? My work schedule varies and we can't always log in at the same time each day?

No. You may log in when you are able. It does not matter if it is early in the morning or in the evening. The lesson is the same. Parents and students will be provided with a suggested pacing guide so that satisfactory progress is being maintained throughout the semester.

3. Will there be things I need to print off?

Generally no. There are a few assignments that occasionally may require you to print something off, but mainly all of the work is done on the computer.

4. Will I need internet?

Yes, the internet will be required to access the lessons and submitting the required assignments.

5. Will my child get a grade?

Yes, your child's performance will be continually updated and you will have an accurate, up to the minute idea of how your child is performing. Students doing online learning will complete an end of course exam, same as in the face to face learning. Students must obtain an overall passing score in order to earn credit for the class

6. What if my child has special needs?

Students with an IEP will be able to have lessons somewhat tailored to them. Every effort will be made to maintain accommodations that can be maintained through a virtual lesson. Obviously, some accommodations that require face to face interaction will not be possible, but just like in face to face school we will honor your child's unique learning needs.
