



## WWSC Reopening Plan

### **Calendar & Schedule-**

WWSC will operate on the calendar that was previously approved by the school board. It is located on the WWSC website.

All breaks will remain the same.

WWSC will do our best to maintain a normal daily schedule. At this time we have no plans to deviate from our traditional schedule.

Upon entering the building students will go directly to their first class. The building will NOT be open to anyone other than staff until 8:00 am. Parents will NOT be permitted to walk their students into the building.

### **Classroom and Social Distancing-**

Students will use their own supplies whenever possible. Shared items will be cleaned regularly.

At this time no other restrictions will be in place.

### **Transportation-**

WWSC recognizes that the school bus is one of the most difficult areas to practice social distancing. Therefore we are limiting occupancy to two children per seat. The only exception to this is if students from one household can fit in the same seat. Students will be given assigned seats and must sit within family units.

We ask that any family that is able to provide their own transportation do so. This will reduce the stress on our bus routes. \*If you make the choice to provide transportation for your children please call 812-755-4872 to report this change.

At this time masks are mandated to be worn on the school bus by the CDC. This could change. Any change will be communicated when we are informed of the change.

### **Special Education-**

WWSC will follow guidance from the INDOE document for the best practices to support students with special education needs.

WWSC will always comply with special education law and provide a quality education to all students.

### **WWSC Virtual Option-**

WWSC will NOT have a virtual option for the 2021-2022 school year.

For students of families that have warranted concerns we asked that you contact the guidance office to look at how we can assist you in best meeting the needs of your child.

### **Senator Parent Responsibilities-**

WWSC is asking that parents monitor their child's health and communicate with the school nurse if your child is ill or is running a fever. Children with symptoms that correspond with symptoms of Covid-19 should be kept home, especially when running a fever greater than 100 degrees.

### **Mask/Face Covering Requirements-**

### **Sick Staff and Student Return to School Protocols-**

WWSC will follow the protocol below for sick staff and students-

- Staff/Students exhibiting multiple symptoms of Covid-19, without an alternate explanation/diagnosis or a negative Covid test, will be asked to stay home.
- Staff/Students exhibiting multiple symptoms of Covid-19, without an alternate explanation/diagnosis or negative Covid test, will be sent home.

- Staff/Students with a fever greater than 100<sup>0</sup> are asked to stay home and shall not return until they are 72 hours fever free and have an alternate explanation/diagnosis or a negative Covid test.
- Staff/Students presenting a fever greater than 100<sup>0</sup> at school will be sent home and shall not return until they are 72 hours fever free and have an alternate explanation/diagnosis or a negative Covid test.
- Individuals with a positive Covid test or without an appropriate alternate explanation/diagnosis or negative test will be required to quarantine based on health department guidance.

### **Contact Tracing-**

When a staff member or student is verified as Covid positive a contact tracing investigation will be completed.

Staff conducting the contact tracing investigation will be conservative when determining those that need to be quarantined.

Every effort will be made to keep students in school unless it is absolutely necessary that they quarantine or need to seek a Covid test.

### **School Closing-**

WWSC will close down at the direction of the health department.

In the event of a school closure, WWSC will implement a school-wide remote learning environment. Remote learning will primarily be virtual. Parents need to have a plan in place in the event of closure. This plan should include childcare and access to the internet.

### **Water (Fountains/Bottles)-**

Students are encouraged to have their own water bottle.

Water fountains will NOT be used.

Water fountains with bottle filling capabilities will be utilized.

### **Guest/Volunteers/Etc.-**

WWSC campus will be closed to visitors and volunteers during the initial reopening of the school year. Guests/Volunteers must be approved by the building administrator.

### **Sanitizing/Cleaning-**

Effective cleaners will be utilized to sanitize the WWSC facility. Documentation of cleaners will be stored on campus.

High traffic and high touch areas will be cleaned and disinfected frequently.

Restrooms will be sanitized throughout the day.

All parts of the building will be thoroughly cleaned nightly and the building will have a sanitizing mist on all surfaces on a nightly rotation.
