WORK-STUDY REGULATION

In accordance with the policy of the board of education, this regulation shall govern the work-study program in the Yale Public School system.

- 1. In order to qualify for the work-study program, a senior high school student must be able to complete graduation requirements during the senior year.
- 2. The student must obtain parental and school permission.
- 3. The student may be absent from school for employment purposes a maximum of one hour each school day, during the last hour of the day. The student must be in attendance for six hours each school day.
- 4. The student must be passing in in all subjects during the first semester to be eligible for work-study the second semester. Classes in physical education, band, vocal music, yearbook, and athletics will not apply toward work-study eligibility.
- 5. School officials may visit the student's place of employment on a periodic basis to insure that the student is maintaining satisfactory employment during the hours the student is excused from class.
- 6. If the student's employment is terminated, the student must obtain other employment within one week or return to full time attendance.

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
