Dear Faculty, Staff and Parents of Luray Elementary School,

In reviewing health data for students and staff and staff capacity levels for Luray Elementary School, and speaking with the Lord Fairfax Health Department the decision has been made to continue the closure of Luray Elementary School through Friday, September 24, 2021. Student learning will continue as described below.

Wednesday, September 22, 2021

- Remote instruction will continue as has been communicated for students in grades PreK-5.

Thursday, September 23, 2021

- PreK - 2nd grade - Teachers will communicate to parents if the pick-up of additional materials is necessary in the main office between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm.
- Grades 3rd - 5th - Continue to log into Schoology to access and complete assignments as well as participate in daily live instruction through Google Meet. These live sessions will be recorded and uploaded to Schoology to be viewed at a later time for students who do not have Internet access.
- PreK - 5th grade - Meal packages are available for pick-up in the main lobby between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm. If parents or guardians have any questions or concerns in regard to meal pick up, please contact the Nutritional Services Department at 540-743-6533.

Friday, September 24, 2021

- Parents/Guardians of PreK - 2nd students should continue to access Class Dojo to view supplemental/support of learning material provided by teachers.
- Students in grades 3rd - 5th should continue to log into Schoology to access and complete assignments as well as participate in daily live instruction through Google Meet. These live sessions will be recorded and uploaded to Schoology to be viewed at a later time for students who do not have Internet access.

Monday, September 27, 2021

- Anticipated return of students in grades PreK - 5th for those who are not isolated, quarantined or symptomatic. Students or staff who have COVID symptoms should not come to school or work.

PCPS continues to encourage everyone to monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. If symptoms do arise, it is recommended that you isolate and consult with your local health care provider for additional guidance.

As we have shared, as a division PCPS understands the incredible challenges a school closure creates for families. This decision has been made with safety first and with a great deal of thought and care for everyone in the Luray Community. PCPS will continue to communicate with faculty, staff and families over the next few days to provide additional information and updates.
