TAX LEVY ORDINANCE Ordinance # 2 1975

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1976, TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF FLEMING, COLORADO FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1976 and ending December 31, 1976

WHEREAS THE TOWN OF FLEMING has adopted a budget for the year beginning January 1, 1976 and ending December 31, 1976

AND WHEREAS, The Town Council has determined that the porper mill levy upon each dollar of the assess valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Fleming is 20.3515 mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING, COLORADO:

That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the Town of Fleming, Colorado, during the year beginning on January 1, 1976 and ending December 31, 1976, there is hereby levied a tax of 20.3515 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Fleming for the year 1976.

That the Twon Clerk is herey authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Logan County, Colorado, the total tax levy for the Town of Fleming, Colorado as is herein set forth.
