Grading System

The District's grading system is designed to enable students and parents to clearly know how well the student is achieving grade level or course expectations and to identify where remedial work is needed.

In order to provide reports of student progress in a form that will be meaningful to students, parents, and teachers, the evaluation system shall be uniform, District-wide, at comparable grade levels.

A grade of pass (P) or fail (F) will be awarded for courses in subject areas approved by the board.

Students must earn a minimum grade of 70 to earn credit for online Edmentum courses.

Students who achieve a score of 83 or higher in an Advanced Placement (AP) course will be awarded 5 additional points toward their final grade for the purpose of determining class standing.

Students who are enrolled in Calculus at Telstar or a 105 or higher level college course, and achieve a score of 83 or above, will receive 3 additional points toward their final grade for the purpose of determining class standing.

Dean's List / Cum Laude - Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above for all academic courses. All individual courses, including Region 9 courses, must be at least a 2.7. Students must have a full academic schedule. If they are in the School to Work Program they must be in good standing. Any Edmentum courses need to be a minimum of 80%.

High Honors / Magna Cum Laude - In addition to the requirements needed for Dean's list / Cum Laude, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or above.

High Honors / Summa Cum Laude - Students must meet the requirements for High Honors plus have a minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.8.
