- Visit <https://hvs.nutrislice.com/>
- Click on the school site you wish to view and the menu will appear.
 - To translate the menu into Spanish – click the globe/world icon and select 'Spanish'
- Printing the menu:
 - Click on the printer icon
 - Under print options you can make the font small or large, add nutritional information, filter allergens and much more!
 - At the end of options, click the 'print' button
- Nutritional Information:
 - Click on the menu item and a picture and nutrition description along with allergens will appear
- Allergens:
 - In the upper right hand corner there select the 3 horizontal lines. An allergen list will pop up.
 - Check off the allergen you would like information on and click the 'X' to close out.
 - Items on the menu containing the allergen will be red and crossed of.
- Carbohydrate Counts:
 - Click on the calculator icon and weekly carb counts for menu items will display
