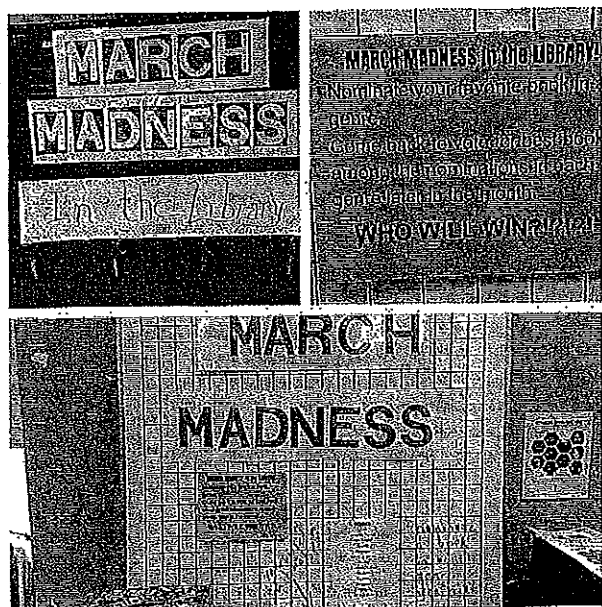

Most students are being very efficient and responsible when given this opportunity.

In addition, there has been an upswing in the number of students coming to the library too work on group projects. Students were recording podcasts and dialogue for Language Arts. Students have met members of their groups in the library so that they could work on their group projects and presentations for Mrs. Burns's sixth grade Science and Mrs. Castiglione's seventh grade Social Studies. 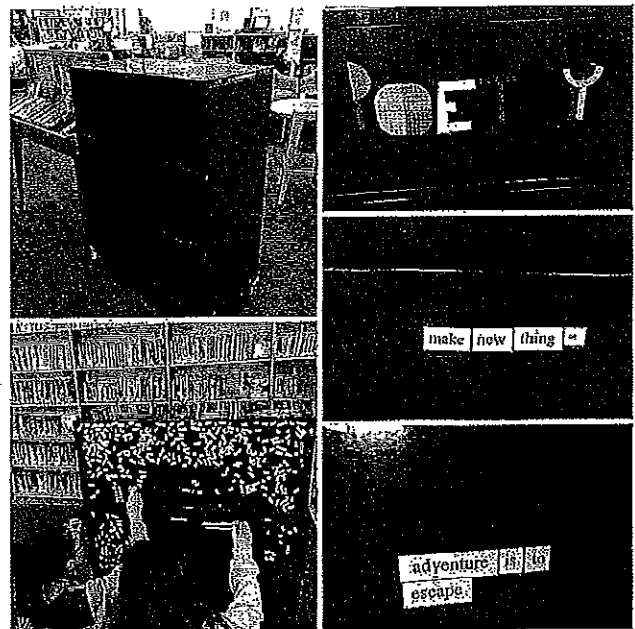

I. EDUCATION

We have been involved in a lot of State test preparation, including scheduling and managing a great deal of information in the Pearson Next system to make testing possible. Many hours of work goes into the admin side of getting ready for this assessment. Teachers have been paying close attention to their pacing as to cover critical skills and concepts prior to test time.

Our school met this month to work on developing a useful scope/sequence writing resource for both grades 4 and 5 that incorporates our new writing series and other writing resources. We also met to discuss, as a school, the topic of homework. We discussed the purpose of homework, what research suggests is the impact of homework at the elementary level, how much and type of homework is effective (and what to avoid), how best to differentiate homework, appropriate consequences of no homework at the elementary level, etc.

Our school-wide PBS initiative continues to evolve and promotes a wonderful school atmosphere centered upon our school's core values -- Honesty, Responsibility, Kindness, and Respect. The new PBS HOUSE system has promoted unity, teamwork, and friendship within our student body. You will learn more about our HOUSE system in the 2019 Spring edition of *The Communicator*.

The Pennsville Education Association and Pennsville Education Foundation sponsored two Morning with Mom events this month -- one for 4th and another for 5th grade students. They were very well attended.

The end of trimester two took place this month.

I continue to make a daily effort to stop by classrooms for visits and join students for lunch. I believe strongly in being visible to my staff as well as students.

Parents continue to bring in medications for their children that need to be administered during the school day. To date, there are two students receiving daily medications including one diabetic student, three students with severe food allergies or other allergic condition that require an epi-pen for emergencies and eleven students with medication as needed.

I continue to have conferences (formal and informal) with several of our families concerning the medical, emotional, and dietary needs of their children. I have also had conferences with DYFS case workers as needed. Continue to participate in 504 conferences as needed.
