Meeting adjourned at 7:37 pm.

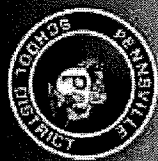

- In ELA, in grades 4, 5, and 7 the percentage of Pennsville students scoring at a level 4 or 5, meeting or exceeding expectations, was equal to or higher than the State.
- The State showed similar or improved scores from 2016 to 2017 for Math, in grades 7, 8 Geo and Alg II. Pennsville results were a little more varied.
- In Math, in grades 4, 5 and 8 the percentage of Pennsville students scoring at a level 4 or 5, meeting or exceeding expectations, was equal to or higher than the State.



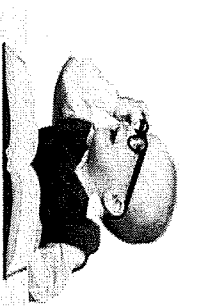
