

ORDINANCE NO. 79, 1921.

CONCERNING MUNICIPAL LIGHT PLANT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
TOWN OF FLEMING:

Section 1: The Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming shall have general and superintending control of the electric light plant of the Town, and the management and operation thereof, and everything relating thereto.

Section 2: An application shall be made to the town clerk for a permit to connect any dwelling house, store, or other building, with electric light. If granted, such permit shall be signed by the town clerk, in his official capacity, and set forth the name of the person for whose benefit such permit is granted; and the town clerk shall keep a record of all permits in a book kept for that purpose, which book shall set forth the substance of each permit issued.

Section ~~2~~:4 Every person who shall apply for a permit to use electric light, under the provisions of this ordinance, shall agree in the said permit to pay for the said lights, or electric power, so used at the following rates, to-wit:

LIGHT RATE

Minimum per month, 10 K. W. - - - - - \$1.65
Additional one K. W. fifteen cents
(15¢) up to fifty K. W.
Above 50 K. W. at ten cents (10¢).

POWER RATE

First one hundred K. W. at twelve cents (12¢),
Second one hundred K. W. at ten cents (10¢),
Third one hundred K. W. at eight cents (8¢);

Minimum \$1.25 per month per horse power. *Connected*

Said rates shall continue in force and effect until such time as the same are increased, or decreased, by action of the Board of Trustees of the said Town; and all contracts for the furnishing of light or power shall be for the term of one month only, and subject to a revision of rates in the discretion of the Board of Trustees of the said town.
