

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING  
RELATING TO  
THE SALE AND EXPLODING OF FIREWORKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING:

SECTION 1. SALE OF FIREWORKS

Business establishments or individual merchants may sell fireworks within the City Limits only between the hours of 12:01 A. M. July 1 to 12 Midnight, July 4.

SECTION 2. EXPLODING OF FIREWORKS

Fireworks may be exploded within the City Limits only on July 4th of any year between the hours of 12:01 o'clock A. M. and 12:00 o'clock Midnight.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

An ordinance prohibiting the shooting of Fireworks within the City Limits of the Town of Fleming on any other day than the Fourth of July is necessitated because of the nuisance created when fireworks are exploding at all hours of the day and night and in the opinion of the Town Council the Fourth of July ONLY has been set aside for celebrating the Declaration of Independence by the exploding of fireworks.

SECTION 4. ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO STATE AND NATIONAL LAWS


This ordinance shall be null and void in the event State or National Laws eventually out-law the sale and exploding of Fireworks. In that event The Town of Fleming will comply with the State and National Laws relating to the sale and exploding of Fireworks.

SECTION 5. VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE


Persons violating this ordinance shall be subject to Fines not exceeding \$25.00 and with a minimum of \$2.00 Fine subject to the nature of the violation and the Town Marshall and his deputies are hereby granted the authority and power to arrest such violators.
