GREEN	-Disease is mild OR Disease is severe but does not spread easily from person to person AND/OR -Disease is being contained and at least two (2) of the following indicators are met: -7-day positivity rate of <5% - 0 new active cases over a 14-day period -No sustained increase in Active cases of at least 5 consecutive days over a 14-day period -0 hospitalizations	Minimal Disruption Individual Quarantine or Isolation measures for exposures and infected	 Conduct daily self-check for symptoms and stay home if symptomatic e.g. fever, cough, etc. Social Distance of at least 6 feet from non-household members Wear face covering in public Avoid high risk areas Follow good hand hygiene Avoid touching face Cover coughs and sneezes Businesses and Govt open with plan Schools in-person with plan and follow Tribal Health Orders regarding education activities
YELLOW	-Disease is severe and spreads easily from person to person but is occurring outside of the Reservation, OR -Disease is spreading within the Reservation, could be severe in vulnerable groups, OR -Disease is being contained and at least two (2) of the following indicators are met: -7-day positivity rate of 5.0% - 7.9% -2 or less new cases over a 14-day period -No sustained increase in Active cases of at least 5 consecutive days over a 14-day period -1-5 Hospitalizations over a 14-day period	Minimal Disruption Individual Quarantine or Isolation measures for exposures and infected	 Follow Green Level safety precautions e.g, mask, hand washing, social distancing Avoid travel to high-risk areas Avoid contact with anyone who is considered high-risk Businesses and Govt open with plan Telework/Hybrid workplace Schools in-person with hybrid plan and follow Tribal Health Orders regarding education activities Gathering less than 50 with safety measures
ORANGE	-Disease is severe and spreads easily from person to person, but disease has not spread widely across the Reservation and is being contained with at least two (2) of the following indicators met: -7-day positivity rate of 8.0% - 9.9% -3-19 new cases over a 14-day period -Sustained increase in Active cases of at least 5 consecutive days over a 14-day period -Greater than 5 hospitalizations over a 14-day period	Moderate Disruption Individual Quarantine or Isolation measures for exposures and infected	 Decrease in-person interactions with others Necessary travel only Limit gatherings to 10 or less Telework/Hybrid workplace Mask mandate/Hand Hygiene Social Distancing Businesses @ 50% capacity Schools-In-person with hybrid plan and follow tribal health orders regarding activities
RED	Disease is severe and spreading widely across the Reservation and at least two (2) of the following indicators are met: -7-day positivity rate of 10% or greater -20 or more new cases over a 14-day period -Sustained increase in Active cases of at least 5 consecutive days over a 14-day period -Sustained increase in hospitalizations -Critical Shortage of hospital staff or PPE	Major Disruption Individual Quarantine or Isolation measures for exposures and infected Lockdown measures e.g. reservation-wide or community focused	 Shelter-In-Place Essential Business only @ 25% capacity Essential Travel only Essential Activities: Food, Supplies, Medical Essential Government Services Telework Schools- Follow Plans approved in accordance with Ordinance 21-03
