




HOW TO REPORT A COVID-19 CASE AT SCHOOL

Updated 9/21/20

Follow the steps below if a student or staff member reports a positive result of COVID-19.



If close contact becomes symptomatic or tests positive for COVID-19, they are now a confirmed or probable case.

If close contact does not develop symptoms they complete quarantine period and can return to school.










WHAT DO SCHOOLS DO WHEN COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OCCUR AT SCHOOL?

SHOULD I REPORT TO SCHOOL?

START HERE Have you tested Have you been in contact **POSITIVE for COVID-19** with someone who have NO NO or are you waiting for tested POSITIVE for a test result? COVID-19? Do you have **YES** COVID-19 symptoms? YES Stav at home for at least YES NO Were you within 6 feet 10 days from the first date of a positive case for 15 of symptoms OR 10 days minutes or more? from your test date if you have no symptoms AND if you have been fever **REPORT** free for 24 hours without TO SCHOOL. the use of fever YES NO reducing medication. A NEGATIVE test is NOT REQUIRED to return 1. Stay at home. to school. 2. Contact your healthcare provider for evaluation and need for testing. You may return to school if a doctor determines that Stay at home for 14 days after the last Report to school. symptoms are due to another exposure to the positive case of COVID-19 diagnosis or COVID-19 is **AND** monitor for symptoms taking temperature ruled out, being fever-free twice a day for a minimum of 14 days. (If at any for 24 hours without the use point your child's temperature is 100.4 or higher. of fever-reducing medicine or your child starts developing symptoms. and improving symptoms. contact your healthcare provider.) All healthy siblings may May return to school after 14 days if no continue attending school symptoms develop. A NEGATIVE test is NOT while ill student is evaluated REQUIRED to return to school. for COVID-19.
