As we stated last week, we are moving to a once a week update instead of the biweekly notes we were doing previously. While we do have some cases to report, we are still seeing most cases relating to adults and /or families.

### Currently

- High School—We have 2 student cases since our last update; 2 total active student cases; Juniors (0), Sophomore (0), and freshmen (2). We have 0 additional employee cases for a total of 0 active employee cases.
- Junior High—We have 2 student cases since our last update; 2 total active student cases; 8<sup>th</sup> graders (0); 7<sup>th</sup> graders (0); 6<sup>th</sup> graders (2). We have 2 additional employee cases a for total of 0 active employee cases.
- Intermediate—We have 0 student cases since our last update; 0 total active student cases; 4<sup>th</sup> grade (0) and 5<sup>th</sup> grade (0). We have 0 employee cases.
- Elementary—We have 1 case since our last update; 1 total active student case; Pk (0), kinder (1), 1<sup>st</sup> grade (0), 2<sup>nd</sup> (2), 3<sup>rd</sup> (0). We have 1 additional employee cases for a total of 2 active employee cases.
- NOTES—we did have a few more student cases, however we have traced most of these cases to situations that involve outside of school connections. Thank you for all you are doing to help keep your children safe. Currently we are seeing attendance increase as well. WE are hopeful that out counts will continue to stay strong.

Again, we will continue to keep our community informed of the cases we have so that you are always able to make the decision for your family that is best for you.
