

STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors, realizing the goal of the public school is to educate students, seeks the input and experience of students in the Waitsburg School District. Therefore, the Board of Directors has created a non-voting, advisory Board position for one Student Representative enrolled in Waitsburg High School. The role of the Student Representative will be to:

1. Provide student insight and perspective to the Board of Directors and District Administration,
2. Serve as a liaison to the students of Waitsburg High School through the established student government and communications networks, and
3. Report to students about the work of the school district and the Board of Directors.

The Student Representative will be bound by all applicable rules and regulations pertaining to the elected Board members. The Student Representative will participate in Board discussions, but will not have the right to make motions, vote, hold Board offices, or attend Executive Sessions.
