Dear Shawano School District Families,

Over the last week we have continued to see an increase of positive cases of COVID-19 in students and staff. In addition, the community rate of COVID-19 continues to be very high.

The safety of our students, staff and our ability to continue face-to-face operations is at risk. At a special board meeting Friday afternoon, the board approved requiring masks district wide. **All students and staff in all buildings are required to wear masks starting Monday September 27<sup>th</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021.** Masks will be required during the normal school day, 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

### **Prevent Further Spread**

COVID-19 is at very high levels in our community. Please remember we all need to do our part to help decrease community spread and keep our schools face to face.

The following guidelines will help to prevent further spread of illness in our schools:

- Notify the school if your child is diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Notify the school if your child had contact with someone who you know was diagnosed with COVID-19.
- **Keep students home from school if they are sick.**
- Get yourself and your child vaccinated as soon as you are able to do so.
- Encourage good habits: frequent handwashing, covering coughs and sneezes and use of face coverings in public.
