At **Mesick Junior High School**, we have a small group of dedicated teachers who focus on the important academic and developmental needs that are unique to this age group. The traditional core academic classes in our Junior High School are enriched by additional classes such as Art, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), computer science, band, and physical education. Students can participate in after school extracurricular activities including Football, Volleyball, Basketball, and Robotics.

In the Senior High School at Mesick, our students enroll in core academic classes and can choose additional courses such as Spanish, STEM, Honors English, Honors Math, Communications, Speech and Debate, Art, Psychology, and more. Some of our 11th and 12th students enroll in university courses at Baker College (Cadillac) or Northern Michigan College (Traverse City) as part of their high school program. Many grade 11-12 students participate in the Intermediate School District's Career and Technical Center programs. Five graduates in the Class of 2021 completed the first year of a 2-year Associate Degree Program in the Early College Program and are now enrolled, at no cost, as 13th Year Students and will complete their Associate Degrees at Baker or West Shore Colleges. The Class of 2021 was awarded \$457,600 in scholarships, including a total of seven full-tuition scholarships to the University of Michigan, Central Michigan University, and Northern Michigan College. High school students also excel outside of the classroom. Our Band performs regularly at football games and other local events and our sports teams have recently won conference, district, and regional championships in football, volleyball, boys' basketball, baseball, and softball.
