

# AFTER A BUSY SUMMER FOR CAPITAL PROJECT, THINGS SETTLE DOWN A BIT

Pioneer's current capital improvement project continues but not quite "full speed ahead."

Summer 2021 saw extensive work at Pioneer High School on multiple fronts, including the physical education locker rooms, front foyer expansion, installation of a video screen on the auditorium stage, and roof replacement.

Delevan Elementary saw the next-greatest amount of work,

with replacement of carpeting in most classrooms with tile flooring.

This fall, work continues at the high school, particularly on second shift. Next year, Pioneer Middle School will see improvements in the library media center and home & careers classrooms.

The \$30 million capital project is slated to be largely complete by Fall 2022.

Over nearly 14 years, Pioneer Middle School has had a long succession of therapy dogs, from Lucy and Mike, to Brinley and Louie (to name but a few). And now, the next generation is getting a start.

Wrigley (or Riggs for short) has started visiting the middle school to meet everyone. His handlers say his mother is a therapy dog in Winter Garden, FL, and his father is a champion show dog in Spain.



Wrigley is the latest in a long line of quality therapy dogs at Pioneer Middle School.

Students were eligible to enter a naming contest at the counseling center. On Sept. 21, all the top 10 names were tossed on the ground, and he chose the slip with Wrigley at random.

Therapy dogs have played a key role at school, especially since the pandemic began in spring 2020. Dogs have been shown to reduce stress, anxiety and blood pressure. The dogs are also used as incentive for students with attendance or behavioral problems.
