How do I complete the FAFSA?

Step 1: Apply for an FSA ID @ www.fsaidth.gov

Each student applying for financial aid and one parent in the household must have an FSA ID. Make sure you write down your username, password, cell phone, email address and challenge questions and keep in a secure location for future use.

Step 2: Complete the FAFSA @ www.fafsa.ed.gov

The FAFSA is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This form determines your eligibility for grants, scholarships, work-study and loans. Most students under the age of 24 will need to include parent information. Students whose parents are divorced or separated and do not reside together, should include the parents' information who provides more than 50 percent of the support for that student.
