Your child is a COVID close contact, now what?



Fully Vaccinated?

NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED

It has been at least two weeks since the second shot of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one shot of Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Monitor for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop.

Had COVID-19?

NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED



Had a positive COVID-19 test in the last five months, but are no longer in isolation.

Must submit the test result to district nurse

Monitor for symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if
symptoms develop.

No vaccination/Masks were worn by close contact and COVID positive case/ 3 to 6 feet social distance maintained



NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED



No vaccination/Masks were worn by close contact and COVID positive case/3 feet or less social distance

THREE QUARANTINE OPTIONS AVAILABLE

- 1) Quarantine for seven days with a negative test on day 6 or 7.

 Return to school on day 8.
- 2) Quarantine for 10 days without testing. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop.
- Test daily for seven days while continuing to come to school as long as test are negative and student is symptom free.

 (Only available for exposures at school)
- *Daily testing results need to be turned in to the office each day.

No vaccine/No mask for either close contact or COVID positive case

TWO QUARANTINE OPTIONS AVAILABLE

*Quarantine for seven days. If you have a negative test on day six or seven, you may return on day 8. Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days and get tested if symptoms develop. *Quarantine for 10 days and get tested if symptoms develop.
