C. Mathematics 3 Credits - which must include:

Algebra (1 credit)

Geometry (1 credit)

- D. Science 2 Credits
- E. Elective 2 Credits in either:

Fine Arts (Band, Chorus, Foreign Language, & Art)

Applied Arts (FCS/Home Ec, Ag, Industrial Arts, Business & Technology)

- F. Physical Education 4 Credits (Or waiver)
- G. Health (0.5 Credit)
- H. Speech (0.5 Credit, which also counts towards English requirement)
- 25 Total Credits are required for graduation.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENT EXCEPTIONS

Approved On-Line

A student enrolled in a correspondence course may receive high school credit for work completed, provided:

- 1. The student assumes responsibility for all fees; and
- 2. The High School Principal approves the course in advance.
- 3. Grades earned in approved distance learning courses count toward a student's grade point average, class rank, and eligibility for athletic and extracurricular activities.

A maximum of 6 units of credit may be counted toward the requirements for a student's high school graduation. Exceptions to this will be at principal's approval.
