We currently have two teachers' openings for next school year along with music and PE. One teacher left us for another district and the other teacher is moving from a classroom back to art. She also gave an update on Summer School. All of the kids who signed up attended except for 1 student. There was extra money left in the grant we got for Summer School so every student that is returning to HPS in the fall was given a summer workbook to take home. If they complete the book and bring it back in the fall they will receive a prize. There is also a summer reading program for kids in grades K-3 called Kids Read Now. Those students are eligible to receive 8 free books mailed to their home.
- **b.** Mrs. Fowler also gave the two-way communication information for the last 4 weeks of school.
