Oologah Students and Families,

'Devious Licks' is a TikTok social media challenge where students steal and damage items from schools, including toilets, soap dispensers, computers, signs, etc.

Oologah students have vandalized restrooms, stealing soap dispensers, toilet paper and paper towel holders. Classroom items are also being taken. Please talk with your students and check their social media accounts. Students who vandalize or steal school property will receive the following consequences:

- A minimum of 5 days of In-School Placement,
- Pay restitution for the replacement of the item and the labor to reinstall or repair any damages,
- Law enforcement referral/citation for vandalism and larceny, or whatever law has been broken.

This is just the most recent example in a long line of illegal or dangerous social media challenges. Talk to your students about the fact the 'Devious Licks' challenge is illegal and could have both short-term and long-term consequences. There are monthly TikTok challenges that have been shared out and all of them will result in serious consequences from the school and law enforcement.

Thank you for working with us and helping to put a stop to these actions so that we can focus on the many positive interactions that are happening every day in our schools!
