THE SCHOOL: Wheatland Union High School, a public school located in the northeastern edge of California's vast central Sacramento valley, serves students in grades 9-12. Established in 1907, the school serves an area over 150 square miles which includes Beale Air Force Base and the communities of Plumas Lake and Smartsville. Wheatland Union High School received a full six-year accreditation in 2017 from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

**ENROLLMENT:** The student population is approximately 993 with a senior class of 179. In the 2021-22 school year, the racial/ethnic composition consisted of: 44.05% White, 30.29% Hispanic or Latino, 2.77% Black, 5.09% Asian, 1.27% Filipino, .92% American Indian, .92% Pacific Islander, 14.68% identify with two or more races.
