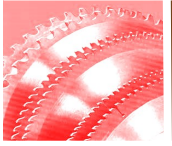

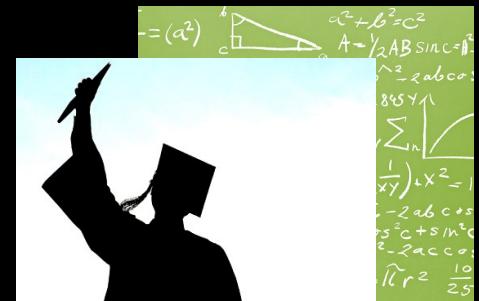
We are excited to work with our students on this new process and can't wait to see the leaders our 8th grade students become. Thank you all for being a part of this great endeavor. We are here to help in any way.
