Who can receive a free influenza vaccine?

All children 6 months old through age 18, regardless of insurance status.

What vaccine type is available?
Injectable (shot).

Can adults (age 19+) receive an influenza vaccine?

Yes, but the vaccine is not free.

What are the payments options for adults?

CCHD can bill your insurance, or you can pay out-of-pocket.

CCHD Accepts:

- Security Health Plan
- Security Administrative Services
- Medicaid/BadgerCare+
- Medicare
- Advocate

You must present your insurance card(s) at the clinic.

Self-Pay Option for Adults:

- \$35.00 per Dose
- Cash or Check ONLY Please
