MEETING NUMBER 2

Bubba McSpadden called the meeting to order. Trey Eckert opened with prayer.

The minutes of the July 23rd meeting was approved as written by a consensus of the board.

The financial reports were approved as presented by the superintendent by a consensus of the board.

A motion by Trey Eckert and seconded by Jeffrey Mounts, passed unanimously to approve the request for prom to be held at the Black Pearl April 18, 2020.

A motion by Jeffrey Mounts and seconded by Trey Eckert, passed unanimously to accept the 2017-2018 legislative audit report.

A motion by Trey Eckert and seconded by Jeffrey Mounts, passed unanimously to approve the Statement of Assurances for Programs Under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA).

A motion by Jeffrey Mounts and seconded by Trey Eckert, passed unanimously to allow Colbey Lawyer to rent the Superintendents house for \$200.00 a month.

A motion by Trey Eckert and seconded by Jeffrey Mounts, passed unanimously to allow the following student transfers out of the district: Ayla Diggs, Toby Moss and Rebecca McBay.

The board adjourned to executive session to discuss of personnel at 7:23 p.m. They returned to open session at 7:50 p.m.

Discussion of items included:

1. JoAnn Walter Elementary has a current enrollment of 306 students. School pictures and kindergarten group pictures will be taken Thursday. Grandparent's breakfast for kindergarten will be Friday, Sept. 6th.
2. Dierks High School has a current enrollment of 250 students. FFA fair season will begin with the Howard County Fair September 2nd – 7th. There are 19 students showing animals this year. The marching band has 30 members and is under direction of new band director, Colbey Lawyer. The Sr. High Cheerleaders have 10 members and a mascot. The Jr. High Cheerleaders have 9 members. Both cheer teams attended the B2 Squared cheer camp in Hot Springs. 4 High School cheerleaders were named All American and 3 Jr. High cheerleaders were named All American at the camp. The Sr. High Outlaws have 19 members, the Jr. High Outlaws have 23 members, and the 7th grade Outlaws have 14 members. The Jr. and Sr. Outlaws will scrimmage Genoa Central on August 27th at Genoa.

Having no further business, the meeting adjourned at approximately 7:51 p.m.
