



PARENT PRESENTATION FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION OCTOBER 6TH, 10:00 AM MORNING SESSION, AND 6:00 PM EVENING SESSION

California Law AB 1767 Suicide Prevention was passed to address the public health issue of suicide being one of the leading causes of death among youth. School personnel who regularly interact with students must be trained to recognize the warning signs of suicide and to offer appropriate referral and/or assistance to reduce suicidal behavior and its impact on students and families. All our 7th and 8th graders participate in a mandatory training each year to help students identify the warning signs of suicide and mental illness to encourage them to seek help from a trusted adult.

With Hope, the Amber Craig Memorial Foundation is a non-profit 501 (c)3 organization (tax ID# 74-3151202) dedicated to suicide prevention through improving mental health awareness and education in our schools and throughout our community.

This Parent Night presentation will provide an overview of what the students will be presented as well as helping parents recognize warning signs of suicide.
