- Our students in grades 3rd-12th will take a survey designed to measure their engagement in school, safety and overall learning environment on April 7, 2021.
- Our school(s) are required to administer this survey, called Conditions for Learning, annually as part of Iowa's plan to meet the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). ESSA replaced the No Child Left Behind Act, and Iowa's plan serves as the foundation for our state's system of school accountability and support.
 - While the Survey is required for 2021, the results data will not be used in the Fall 2021 accountability calculations.
- Research shows students thrive academically when they feel safe, actively engaged in their learning, and when they have positive relationships with adults and other students at school.
- Results from the Conditions for Learning survey also will serve as a great tool to help our schools, teachers, and parents identify areas of strength, as well as areas that may need attention or support.
- Our students' participation in the survey is very important to our school because results can help us build an action plan to improve the learning environment. A high rate of completion means getting the best data possible.
- For students, the survey is an important opportunity to be heard and to be part of efforts to improve their learning environment. We appreciate the community's support in communicating to students about this great opportunity.
- Survey results are confidential. No district, school, or Department of Education staff will have access to identifiable student data.
- While our students will be encouraged to answer as many questions as possible, they will not be required to answer any questions that make them feel uncomfortable.

When to keep your child home from school (Non-COVID related sickness)-

Please keep the health of others in mind when deciding on whether to keep your child home or send them to school. If they have vomited or had diarrhea within the past 24 hours, have a fever of 100.0 or higher, have an undiagnosed rash, or sore throat please do not send them to school. They should be fever free for 24 hours without the help of fever-reducing medication or have taken a prescribed antibiotic for 24 hours before returning to school.

When to stay home COVID related-

Stay home when:

You have been in "close contact" with someone positive with COVID-19.

Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes of someone positive for COVID-19, when either person was not wearing a mask.

You have any high risk symptoms:

- New Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smells

You have two or more low risk symptoms or your symptoms are not within your "norm"

- headache
- muscle / body aches
- fatigue
- sore throat
- runny nose
- fever or chills do not come to school if you have a temp > °100 regardless if you don't have other symptoms
- sinus pain/
- congestion
- nausea
- vomiting
- diarrhea

Minutes of Meeting

Twin Cedars Board of Directors March 8, 2021 5:00 PM

The regular meeting of the Twin Cedars Board of Directors was held on the above date.

President Kelly Carlson called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Directors Mike Weldon, Heather Dunkin, Jolinda Fairchild and Steph Sterner were present. Kim and Dave Roby, Scott Bridges and Mark Bacus were also in attendance.

A motion was made by Director Fairchild and supported by Director Sterner to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Director Dunkin and supported by Director Weldon to approve the February 9, 2021, regular meeting minutes and February 10, 2021 Special Meeting minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Financial reports were reviewed and filed for audit.

A motion was made by Director Weldon and supported by Director Sterner to approve the bills as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Communications

Mark Bacus shared his work list for the summer. He had gotten quotes for the geo-thermal fix. He also shared a list of things on a 5 year plan. Mr. VanderSluis let the board know about the ESSER II money that the district will be receiving. This can be used for air systems so that is one thing the district is looking at replacing the older units at the elementary that haven't already been replaced. There will be some cement work, eaves, and the normal summer cleaning going on. There will be 2 more elementary classrooms getting new cabinets, sinks, and flooring replaced.

There were questions about the cancellation of the Saber Dance and the school play being done virtually. Marion County public health guidelines are being used to help make these decisions. Prom and the Senior Trip are being planned now. There may be mitigations necessary but unless something changes, these will go on as planned. The Elementary Track and Field Day has been approved for May at this time.

Administration Reports

Mrs. Roby shared the calendar and the CTE/SIAC meeting list and agenda. The career fair is scheduled for March 24th. A virtual Family Fair will be March 30th. ACTs will be given on Tuesday and the NCRC is scheduled for April 6th. She reviewed the Summer School policy with the board.

Mr. Roby shared what the governor proposed for ineligibility. The board agreed that Twin Cedars could adopt it and drop the D's off the ineligibility check for the district for now. This will be reviewed in the summer along with the other Student Handbook items. Mr. Roby has had a couple of people interested in the assistant softball position. No recommendations at this time. There have been a couple of speakers at the high school. Desi Payne and Mike Smith have spoken to the students. Girls basketball tied-3rd for conference. Brooke Roby - unanimous first team all conference, All-Elite BGC –KMAland, All-Junior team BGC, KMAland. Rylee Dunkin - 2nd team all conference, All-sophomore team KMAland. Tied school record in assists in a game (10) Cheyanne Bruns - Honorable mention BGC. Boys basketball - Devin Arkema, 2nd team BGC. Kade Dunkin - Honorable mention BGC.

Mr. VanderSluis' report will be covered in the budget review.

New Business

Mr. VanderSluis reviewed the budget information. He gave the board a packet of financial terms and how they relate to the budget process. He gave the history of enrollment, tax rate, and Solvency ratio. The board decided on a 5% Income

Surtax with a 14.07 Property Tax rate. This will be published to the newspaper. The FY 22 calendar was shared and reviewed by the board.

Motion made by Fairchild and supported by Dunkin to set the date and time of the FY 2022 budget hearing for April 7, 2021 at 5:00pm. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Sterner and supported by Weldon to approve the sharing agreements with Oskaloosa Community School District for Transportation and Building and Grounds Services for the FY 2022. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Weldon and supported by Dunkin to accept Marty Duffy's resignation for the 2021-22 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Sterner and supported by Fairchild to accept Mike Bennett's resignation for JH Football for the 2021-22 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Dunkin and supported by Sterner to accept the 2 year contract for Training Wheels for the FY 21 and FY 22. Motion carried unanimously.

Be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Twin Cedars Community School District approves the transfer of \$17,280.92 from the General Fund to the Local Option Sales Tax Fund for expenditures that occurred between July 1, 2020 and August 11, 2020 related to COVID-19, and that the district will receive funding from the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Act.

Motion was made by Director Fairchild and supported by Director Weldon to adopt this resolution. Motion carried unanimously.

The next board meeting will be Monday, April 12th at 5:00.

A motion was made by Director Dunkin and supported by Director Fairchild to adjourn the meeting at 7:41 PM. The motion carried unanimously.
