Each year, the flu causes up to 60,000 deaths and up to 800,000 hospitalizations. The best way to prevent the flu is to be vaccinated.

The time of year is once again upon us to start thinking about protecting ourselves from the flu. We are very pleased to announce that Sanford Luverne Clinic, your school district, and the Luverne Area Community Foundation will be offering flu vaccines to all children enrolled in grades K-12.

We will bill your insurance for the flu vaccine if you have coverage. However, through collaboration with the Luverne Area Community Foundation, all out-of-pocket and non-insured costs will be covered for school-aged children.

The in-school flu shot clinic will be held on Wednesday, October 13, 2021.

To receive the flu shot, the attached consent forms must be completed and returned to the school by **Monday, October 11.**
