Italy ISD Summer School More Information

The ***Italy ISD Summer School Program*** will be offered to:
Students in **Grades PK-6** who (*one or more may apply*):

- participate in our emerging bilingual program (PK-1st).
- are recommended by their teacher(s).
- lack sufficient progress as demonstrated on MAP assessments taken throughout the school year.
- STAAR performances indicate a need for continued accelerated instruction to minimize learning loss over the summer (*Current school year and/or previous school year STAAR performance*).

LIMITED Summer School is being offered for elementary attendance and only with principal approval.

Students in **Grades 7-8 and EOC students** who (*one or more may apply*):

- lack sufficient progress as demonstrated on MAP assessments taken throughout the school year.
- STAAR performances indicate a need for continued accelerated instruction to minimize learning loss over the summer. (*Current school year and/or previous school year STAAR performance*).

NO Summer School is being offered for JH/HS attendance recoupment for class credit.

Dates/Times

Classes begin Wednesday, May 31st and end on Thursday, June 22nd. Classes will be held at Stafford Elementary from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Attendance

Regular student attendance is strongly encouraged in order for the students to receive the maximum benefit. Students may not miss more than one (1) day of summer school. Missing more than one (1) day results in loss of credit and the student will be removed from summer school. Three tardies count as one (1) absence. Arrival after 30 minutes will count as two tardies.

PK-2nd grades will focus on a variety of foundational literacy and math skills. Grades 3rd-8th will focus on Reading and Math coursework. Other subjects may be infused into the daily lesson plans. High school courses will focus on supporting EOC subjects (English I, English II, Algebra I, and Biology).

BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

1. I will do all work assigned so that I can get the most out of summer school. Students not doing all work assigned to the best of their ability will be dropped from summer school and lose their opportunity to make up their assigned course. These students will have to repeat the grade.
2. I will dress appropriately every day. No short shorts, halter or tank tops, flip flop sandals, shower shoes, cut-off jeans or short skirts. Pants must be worn w/belt at the waist and shirts must be tucked in. Inappropriate dress will cause a student to be sent home and result in an absence.
3. I will not miss more than one (1) day of summer school. Missing more than one (1) day results in loss of credit and the student will be removed from summer school. (Late registration counts as absence.) Three tardies count as one (1) absence. Arrival after 30 minutes will count as two tardies.
4. I will behave appropriately, be respectful of teachers, administrators, and other students. Students will be referred to the office one time for behavior issues. On the second referral to the office, students will be dismissed from summer school and lose their opportunity to make up their assigned course.
5. I will not fight, bring any controlled substance or weapons of any kind to summer school or threaten anyone. Doing any of these things will result in immediate dismissal and loss of credit.
