

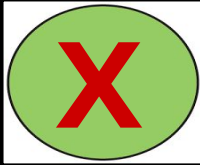

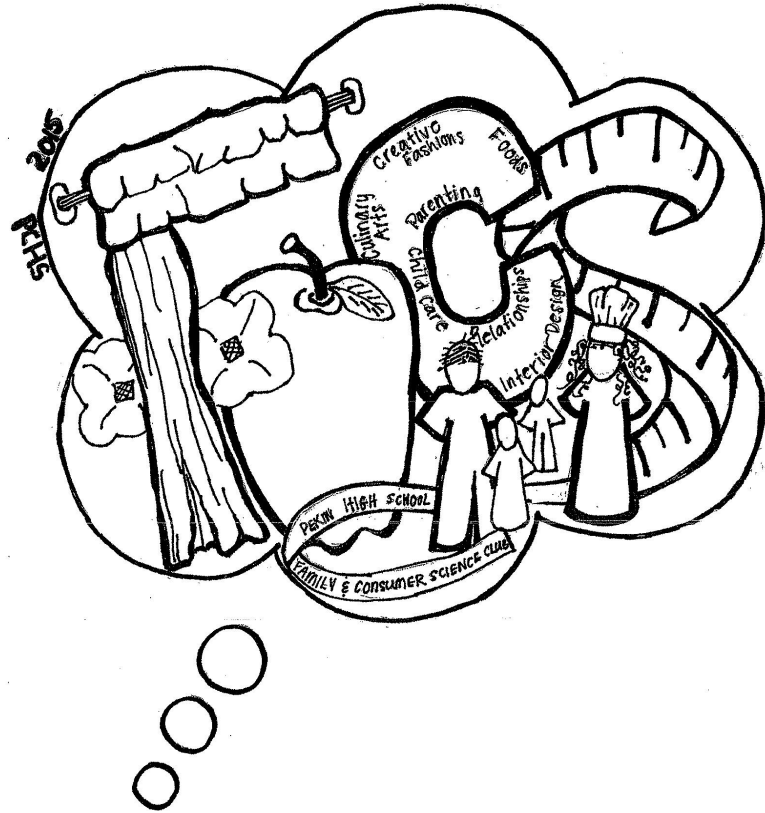

***All seniors, regardless of income, should complete the FAFSA each year.***

The FAFSA will be completed using your **2020** tax documents.

**Please bring your PCHS Chromebook.**

You and your student will **EACH** need to create an **FSA ID**. This can be completed at <https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>. Your student **SHOULD NOT** use your email address or his/her/their Pekin High email address to create his/her/their ID as he/she/they will not have access to it after graduation. Each **FSA ID** must use a unique email address. Make sure to write this information down in a safe place.

**How:** Register at the BFO by **OCTOBER 67th**.

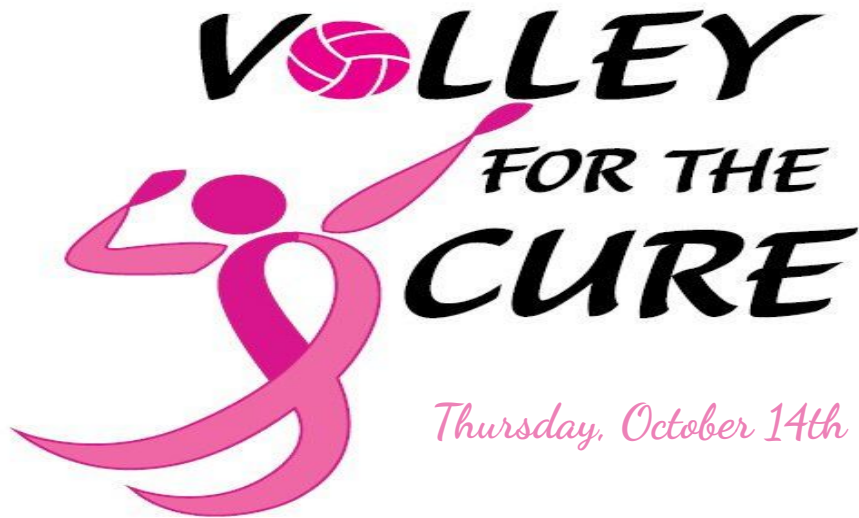
The **\$18.00** Fee will be due at time of Registration.
