By doing this, Emerson plans to accomplish the following goals:

Goal 1: Increase Student Growth in Mathematics

Emerson Elementary will increase student growth in Mathematics by 5% on I-Ready diagnostic assessments from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year. All K-5 students receive differentiated math instruction by classroom teachers, special education teachers, and Title I teachers on an as needed basis. Emerson will use i-Ready to support and enhance classroom instruction. Grade level collaboration meetings will be held weekly to participate in data analysis.

Goal 2: Increase Student Growth in English/Language Arts

Emerson Elementary will increase student growth in English Language Arts by 5% on I-Ready diagnostic assessments from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year. All K-5 grade students will participate in guided reading groups using text appropriate materials for their reading/writing abilities. Four full-time Title I interventionists, two full-time reading resource teachers, and four Special Education teachers provide differentiated instruction for at-risk students.

Goal 3: Increase Parent Involvement

Parent trainings will be offered monthly by our Title I program to K-5th grade parents. These trainings may include family math/reading events, Roll and Reads, Technology training for parents, Parent Resource Fairs, etc. All programs include provided resources with hands-on activities for families to work with their children at home. Due to COVID-19, parent trainings may move to a virtual format. Emerson Elementary also collaborates with parents to create a Parent/Teacher Association that organizes events such as Trunk or Treat, School Carnivals, Field Day, Purse Bingos, and our Secret Santa Shop.
