

BELIEFS BEHAVIORS OUTCOMES

20 Square Feet is simply a metaphor that expresses the reality that each person in the district has a sphere of ownership. The way we behave personally – the way each of us manages our 20 Square Feet – is what determines our culture.

EVENT + RESPONSE = OUTCOME

The key to producing outcomes is not the events you encounter, but how you choose to respond. It's the R-FACTOR.

PRESS PAUSE

Before you respond, slow down and give yourself time to think. Focus on understanding the situation and what you are trying to accomplish. Get off autopilot. Be exceptionally clear about the EVENT you are experiencing and the OUTCOME you are pursuing.

GET YOUR MIND RIGHT



Pay attention to your inner RESPONSE.
Get into a productive mindset by taking ownership of what you focus on and the story you tell yourself.

STEP UP



Respond above the line. Engage in the best possible RESPONSE given the OUTCOME you want and the situation you are in. When circumstances call for it, elevate your RESPONSE. RESPONSE is most important when the EVENT is most difficult.

ADJUST & ADAPT



Get good at change. Life requires you to make changes whether you are ready or not. Success goes to those who are adaptable.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE



Create great experiences for others. Your attitude and behavior are deeply personal but rarely private. What you do has a profound Impact on the people around you. Your R is an E for others.

BUILD SKILL



Be intentional about the habits you develop. Your behavior patterns have you on a path. Develop the habits and skills that will take you where you want to go.
