Marysville students explore career options at Military Careers Day

MARYSVILLE, WA – The Marysville School District Career and Technical Education (CTE) Department will welcome the United States Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps and other military professionals on May 10, 2018 for a day of learning and career exploration. Students in grades 11 and 12 from each Marysville School District high school will come experience the excitement at this one-of-kind career day event featuring all military branches.

This event is a first for the Marysville School District and its Career and Technical Education Department. Students will have an opportunity to get up close and personal with military equipment such as the Army’s Chinook Helicopter, a Coast Guard vessel, and Hummer trucks from the National Guard. Personnel from all branches of the military will also be present to share information on training, education, and other opportunities.

“This is not a military recruitment event, it is part of our goal as educators and advocates to show Marysville students every opportunity available for their future,” said Career and Technical Education Director, Donneta Oremus. “We’re proud of our partnership with the organizations in our community that protect and serve our country, and we appreciate their willingness to go above and beyond the call of duty to share experiences and opportunities with our students.”
