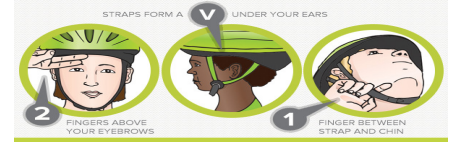

Bicycle Safety Tips for Bike Month

Wear a properly fitted helmet every time they ride, scooter, or skate.

Here is how it should fit.



- Actively supervise children until you're comfortable that they are responsible to ride on their own.
- Teach your kids to make eye contact with drivers.
- Tell your kids to ride on the right side of the road, not against it. Stay as far to the right as possible.
- Use appropriate hand signal and respect traffic signal, stopping at all stop signs and stoplights.
- When riding at dusk, at dawn or in the evening be bright and use lights- and make sure your bike has reflectors as well.
