We have been made aware of continued social media Tik Tok challenges for each month of the school year. If you follow the news, you have likely read that September's challenge was referred to as "Devious Licks" with the objective to vandalize a school restroom and/or steal small items from school buildings. We are disappointed to report that some of our students accepted the challenge and caused damage to multiple restrooms in the middle school and high school buildings.

Now that October is here, the new challenge of "smack a staff member" has been presented. We need your help and support in reminding your students about our expectations of being safe, engaged in learning, respectful, and responsible. Should our students choose to engage and/or participate in any capacity in these behaviors, they will be given full school discipline which may include suspension, expulsion, or removal from extra curricular activities in addition to legal implications.

The following is a list of these inappropriate behaviors and challenges:

September: Devious Licks (vandalize a bathroom and/or steal items from the building)

October: Smack a staff member

November: Kiss your friend's girlfriend at school

December: Deck the halls and show your ***** (show your private areas)

January: Jab a breast

February: Mess up the school signs

March: Make a mess in the courtyard or cafeteria

April: Grab some eggs (another stealing challenge)

May: Ditch day

Please talk to your child about good decision making, monitor their social media activity, and help support us in emphasizing the importance of respect and responsibility. There is no place in our society, and especially in the Geneva Area City Schools, for this type of behavior. Thank you for your continued support and help in addressing this issue.
