## COVID-19 DASHBOARD AND UPDATES

The Aromas-San Juan Unified School District (ASJUSD) is committed to providing accurate and transparent information regarding COVID-19 cases on our campuses while maintaining privacy and confidentiality for our students and staff. The data below represents the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases, including students and staff on our campuses. This data will be updated weekly on Mondays. In the event of a positive case, parents of students who were identified as a close contact and would be required to quarantine, will be notified directly by the Principal. The data for a positive case will be removed when the individual is cleared to return to campus, following California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidance. Tables do not include quarantined individuals who have not tested positive for COVID.

### COMMUNICATION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF A CONFIRMED POSITIVE CASE

1. How do you determine what students need to isolate after a positive test?
  - A close contact is someone who was within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before symptoms appeared (or, for patients who do not have symptoms, two days prior to their test) until the time the patient is isolated.
  
2. How will I be notified if my child is identified as needing to be quarantined?
  - Parents will receive a phone call from the principal if their child(ren) is being asked to quarantine along with a letter.
  
3. How will you notify me if there is a positive situation in the school that does not affect my child?
  - You will **only** be contacted if your child is affected directly.

#### **WHAT YOU CAN DO TO LIMIT THE SPREAD**

We are committed to a collaborative effort to keep our students and staff safe. In addition to health and safety measures taken on our campuses, we encourage you to be proactive and reinforce the importance of **vaccination, hand-washing, physical distancing and face coverings to limit the spread of COVID-19**. Also, if a member of your household tests positive for COVID-19, please keep your child(ren) at home and notify your child's school immediately. If you or your child have any symptoms associated with COVID-19, your child is to stay home and get tested if necessary.
