Location & Time:

- Dance is **Saturday, Oct 9** at [Highland Town Square](#) from **7:00-11:00 PM**-**Gates open at 6:30 PM**

Student Entry, Exit, and Parking:

- Tickets will not be sold at the door and must be purchased in advance
- Students should enter Homecoming Dance at the locations below to check-in and receive a wristband:
 - **Entry 1**-Corner of [Main Street & Washington](#) (near Broadway Tire and Battery)
 - Chartered buses drop off and students enter at [Main & Washington](#)
 - **Entry 2**-Corner of [Main & Laurel](#) (near Marx Brothers Restaurant)
 - Parent Drop Off and student entry at [Main Street and Laurel](#)
- **Drop Off & Parking:** Students who drive & park on-site may enter from either side
 - Parking will be limited and drops offs & carpools are encouraged
 - Parking Areas: Kloss, Post Office, Weinheimer, Library, Lory, Chippers, Street Parking, etc.
 - Check the Homecoming Map below for details
- Only HHS students & their guests are permitted (students with guests must have submitted a [guest pass](#) in advance.)
- All students and guests should bring some form of identification (ex-school ID, Driver's License, State ID,)

Important Homecoming Dance Items:

- Outside food and drinks are not permitted
- Fencing will be used to maintain a safe perimeter-Once students leave the dance, they may not return.
- Bring a jacket/dancing shoes when you enter as students may not return to vehicles for personal items
- Public restrooms will be available for those attending the dance located on the north side

Homecoming Dance Guidelines & Expectations:

- All Highland CUSD #5 Handbook policies are in effect during Homecoming events, and alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes, and other illegal items are not allowed.
- Please communicate positive expectations at home and know you're not alone when implementing guidelines that promote safety and sound decision-making.
- Party Buses have become popular transportation recently and we encourage safe travel to and from events. Buses associated with Homecoming may be searched at the dance if needed
- HHS Admin, Faculty, and Highland PD will be at the dance to maintain a safe and secure environment.
- Make good decisions and be safe-Please don't drink and drive; don't show up to the dance intoxicated or under the influence of any illicit substances. We want everyone to have a safe and fun weekend.
- Masks are not required, but students who feel more comfortable should wear them. Students with any of the following symptoms may not attend the Homecoming Dance per IDPH: Fever (100.4°F or higher), new onset of moderate to severe headache, shortness of breath, new cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, new loss of sense of taste or smell, fatigue from an unknown cause, muscle or body aches from an unknown cause.
