Federal Pell Grant - www.fafsa.ed.gov

- Based on need and family size
- Uses income tax information from 2016 tax return
- Not required to be paid back

Federal Student Loan - www.studentloans.gov

- Based on need
- Must be repaid - payments start 6 months after departure from the educational program

Local/Institutional Scholarships

- Eligibility is determined by need as determined by local scholarship committees
- Not required to be paid back

Outside Scholarships

- Alliance Career Center also accepts any outside scholarships that students have been awarded
