They put up 28 PRs and Season Bests including 2 school records! Bailey broke a 33 year old record in the Discus by nearly 3 feet and Chase broke his own record in the 400. Both boys' relays cut 10 or more seconds and are starting to round into shape for the end of the season. In fact the 4X400 is within 1.5 seconds of our time from last year and that group earned state medals. By the time this is published, we will have competed at a large 20-school meet at Burlington. We're down to about a week until the League Meet and we hope to keep the momentum that has been building the last few meets.
