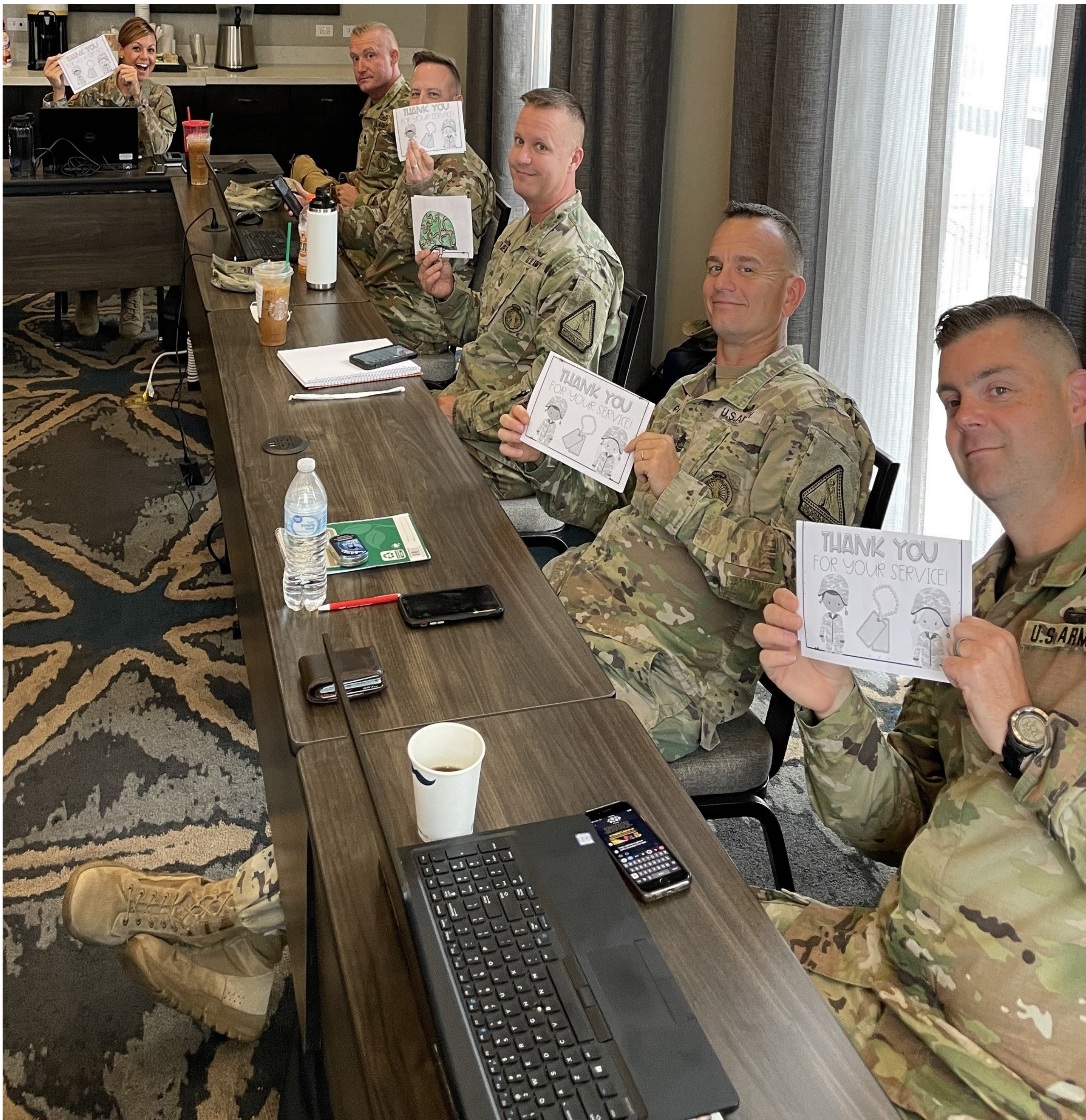

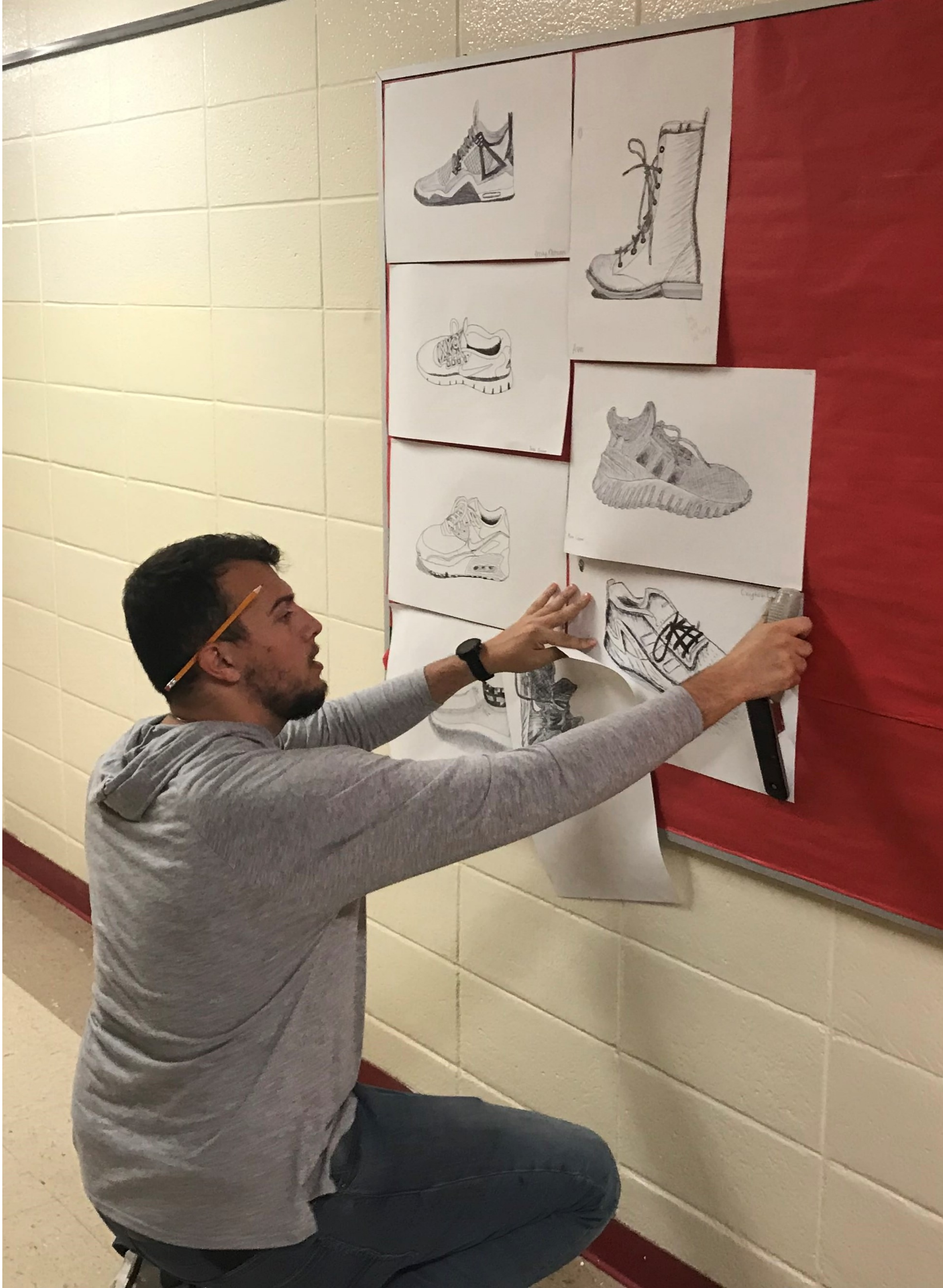

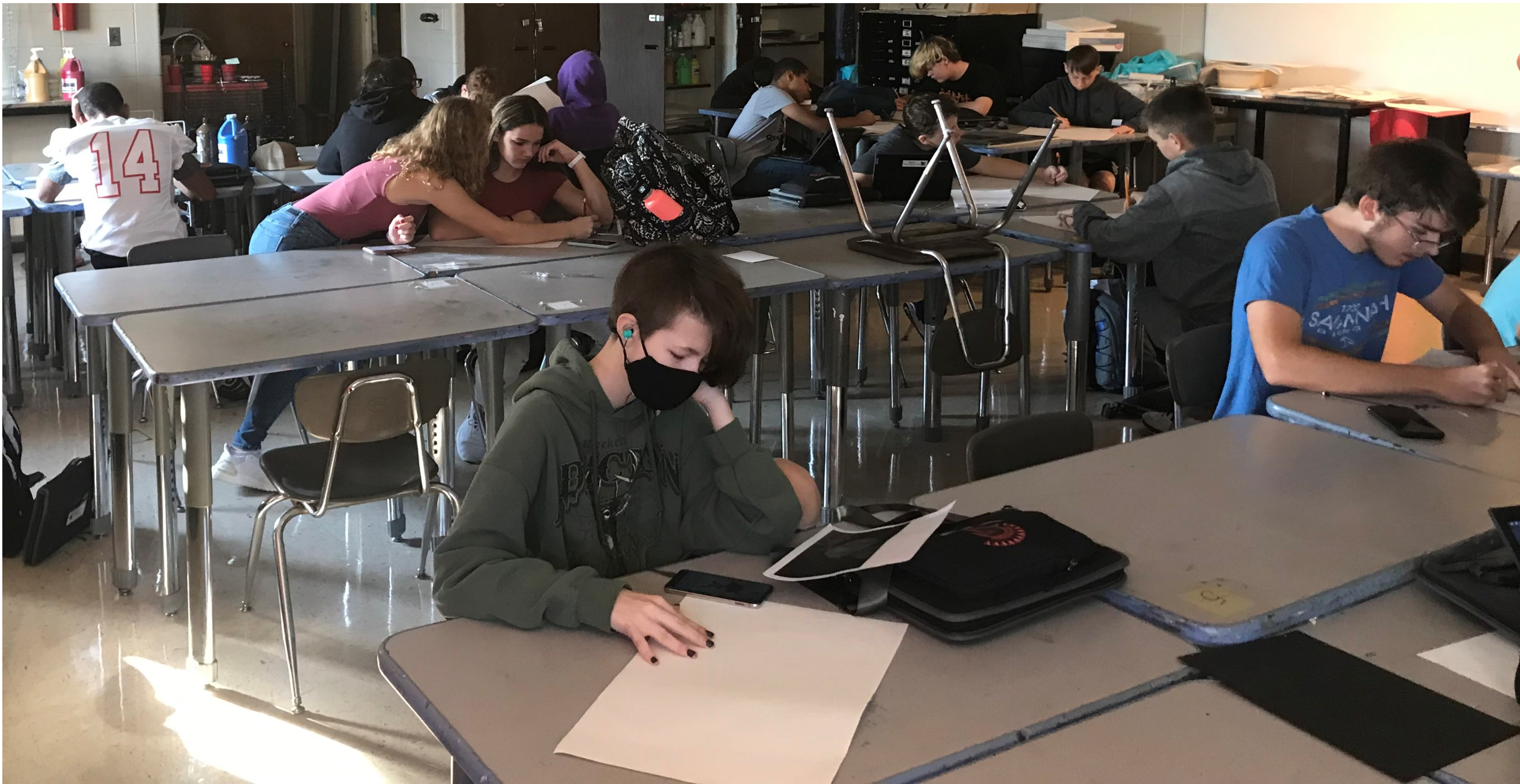

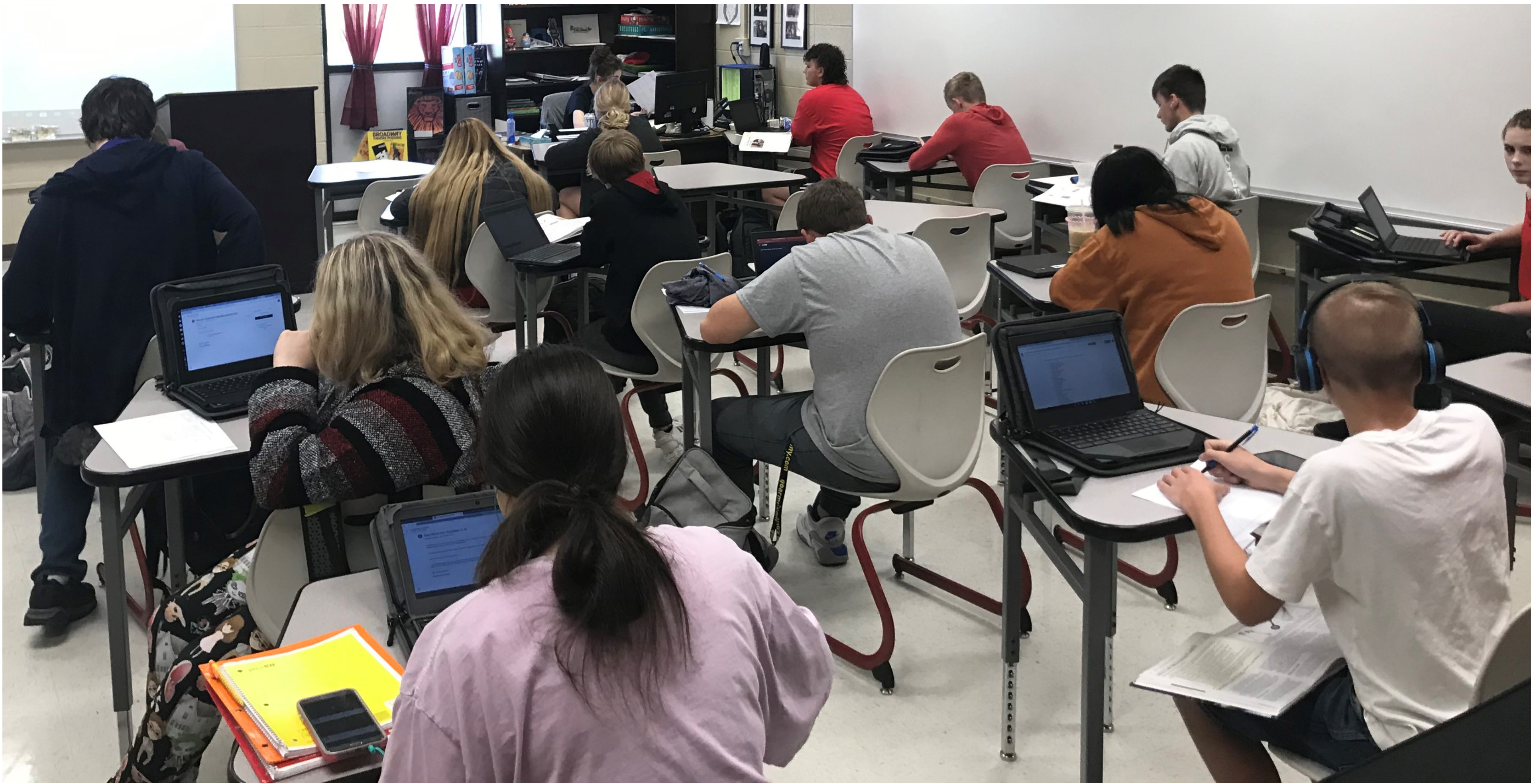

RHS Small Engines Class

Mrs. Allen's Small Engines class is a new class offered for the first time at Richmond High School this 2021-2022 school year. This course is beginning with 13 students, 5 donated engines from Briggs & Stratton, 9 donated engines from Kohler Engines and more than \$9,000 in tools and equipment. The tools and equipment were purchased with Missouri DESE Career & Technical Education grant and support of our school district.

The students have been anxiously awaiting to perform the initial test run of the Briggs & Stratton 1150 series 250cc engines OHV single cylinder engines. The initial test run ensures the engines run before students start taking them apart. So far in the semester, students have learned engine components and operation, 4-stroke and 2-stroke theory. Throughout the semester, students will tear the engine completely down to the block, learning how each part works before reassembling. The goal of the class is for each student to pass the Briggs & Stratton technician certification test.

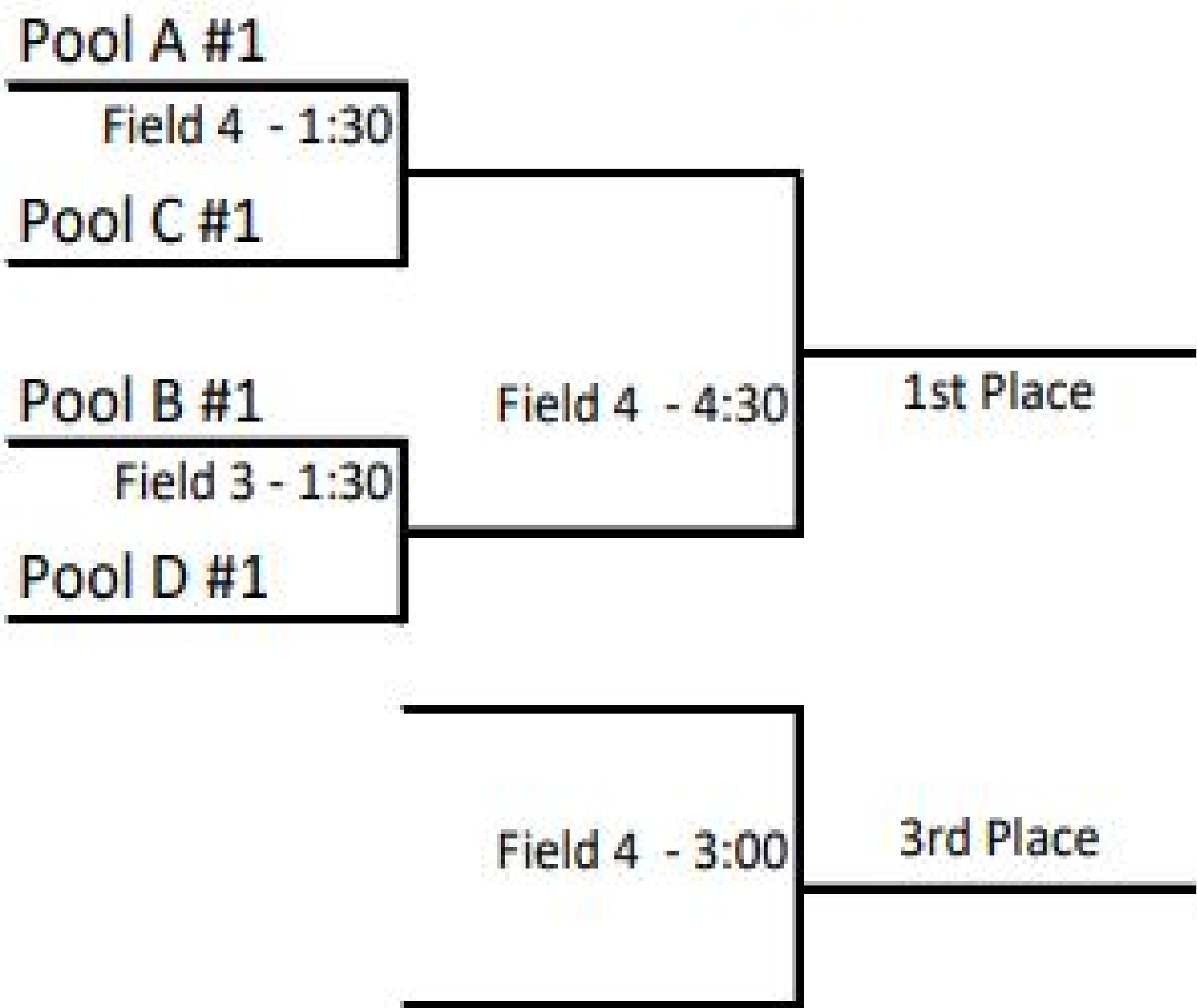

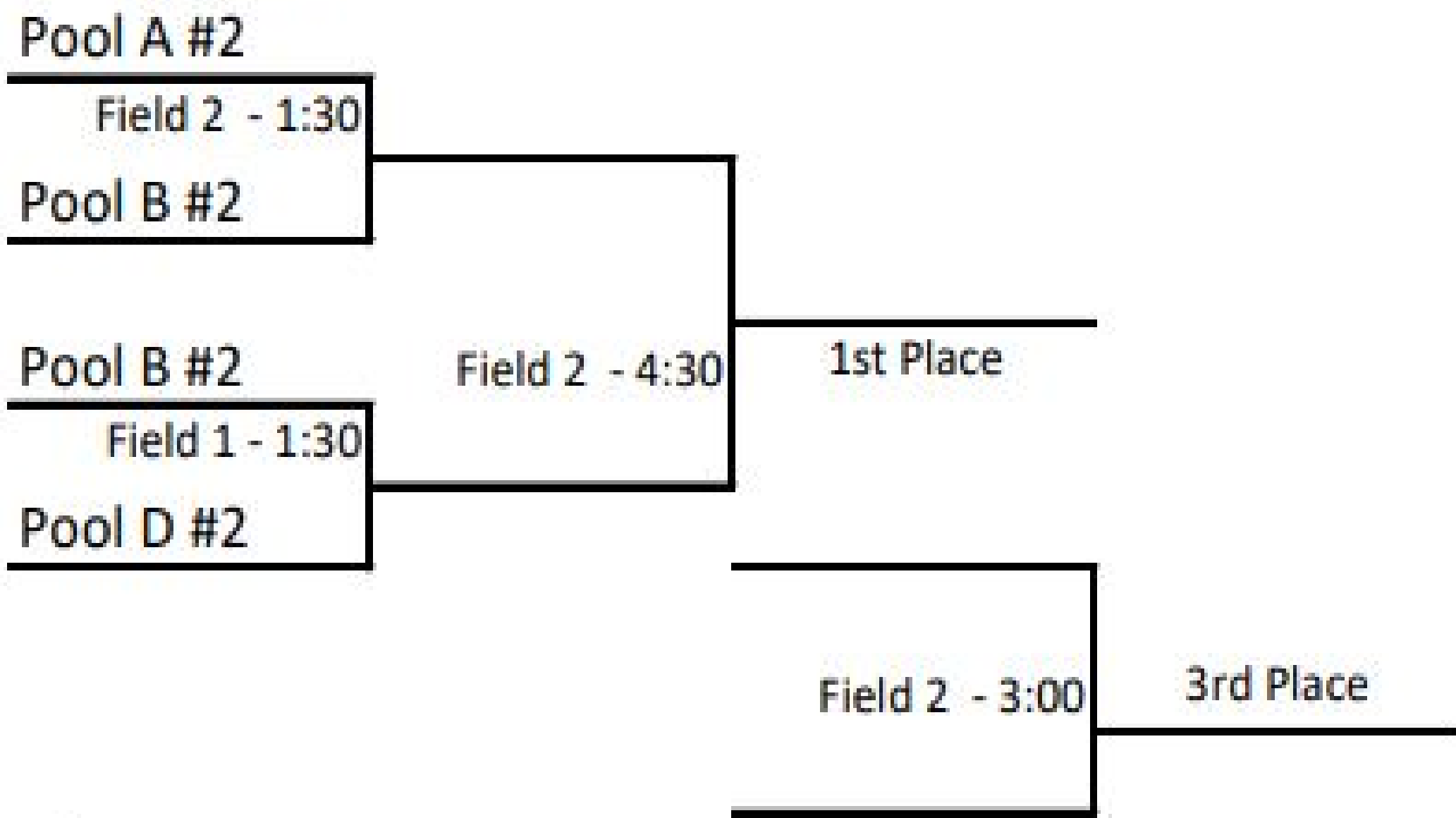
