
Revision to the 2021-22 Restart Plan

Effective October 12, 2021

- 1. Expectations All students will continue to attend school five (5) days per week for in-person instruction.
- 2. Mask Requirement versus Mask Recommendation
 - The District will determine whether or not masks will be required or recommended based on the level of community transmission data provided by the Centers for Disease Control. The data can be publicly monitored at the following web address:

covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#county-view



- During the designated HIGH level of community spread all students, staff and visitors will be required to wear a mask while indoors. When the level of community spread drops to the SUBSTANTIAL, MODERATE, OR LOW designations, all students, staff and visitors will be highly recommended to wear a mask while indoors. The decreased level will need to be in place for a two week period before the transition to the highly recommended mask will be implemented.
- The District will monitor the CDC data and announce any masking changes on our website, all-calls and social media posts.
- As of October 11, 2021, the community transmission level is at a HIGH level and all students and staff are required to wear a mask while indoors.
- Transportation Students utilizing school transportation are still required to wear a mask while being transported on a school owned vehicle per the CDC public transportation mandate.
- Please continue to monitor and perform health self-assessments each day before reporting to school. If symptoms are present, please do not attend.
