Verbal intimidation/ Harassment/Bullying	<ul> <li>Teasing</li> <li>Name calling</li> <li>Low-intensity, but inappropriate, verbal aggression</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Verbal abuse</li> <li>Deliberately delivering disrespectful messages in any format related to gender, sex, ethnicity, race, religion, disability, physical features, or other protected class</li> </ul>
