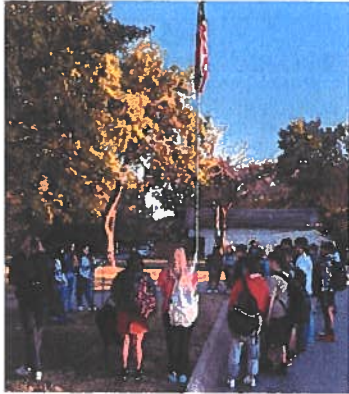




COMMERCE HIGH SCHOOL NEWSLETTER Sept. 2021

The first pep assembly was held outside the 17th. Softball, cheer, band and football were all introduced.

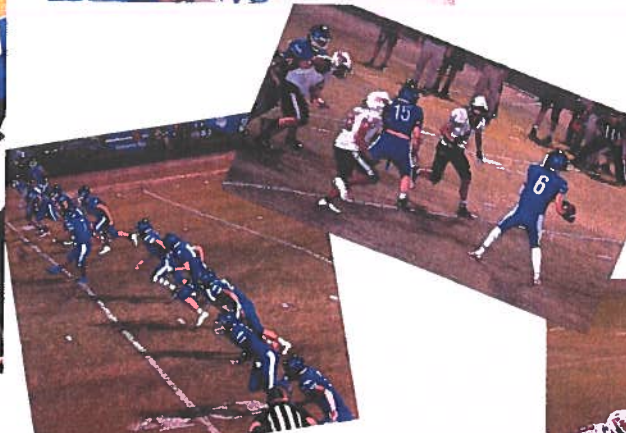
