State of the District

The 2020-21 school year was unlike any year any of our teachers or students have experienced previously. The Covid-19 pandemic caused many changes to our daily protocols and procedures. As a district, we asked a lot of our staff and students to keep everyone safe and to keep school running as normally as possible. Our staff and our students did an exceptional job, and we were able to keep the Covid-19 disruptions to a minimum. At times, some students or grades had to go home, but for the most part we were able to avoid major or extended shutdowns school wide. Keeping the students in the classrooms was a benefit to the overall education we could provide to our students. Our athletic teams were able to compete and complete all of their seasons with the spring season capping off with a State B Girls Golf Championship. As we move into the 2021-22 school year, we hope that this pandemic is behind us and we can get back to school-as-normal, but time will tell, and we are excited to embrace anything that comes our way.

The 2020-21 school year also saw many changes and upgrades to the school facilities as well. In the fall, the district was able to upgrade the Beckman Field Scoreboard and Sound System through generous donations from local businesses and the Alumni Association. The new scoreboard looks great and sounds even better. During the summer of 2021, the track will be resurfaced, resealed, and repainted and will be like a brandnew track when the work is completed. We are very fortunate to have such a beautiful facility in our school district. In July, the lighting in the Estelline Arena was changed over to LED lighting and it no longer has that orange hue to it!

The school district also received some federal funding to be used to help with the Covid-19 pandemic and getting the school ready for the new year. We were able to use that money to do a variety of projects throughout the school district:

Changed all bathroom fixtures to touchless and automatic. Upgraded many janitorial supplies and equipment. Replaced original air handling system in the high school. Replaced all exterior doors throughout the school. Replaced all windows in the elementary and middle school.

Whether it was the donation of the new digital Clarinova piano for the music program or the scholarships you provide our seniors, the generosity never goes unnoticed. BOB FOSTER (79), a member of the Rolling Thunder, Inc., Chapter II of South Dakota, was successful in securing the support of the Capitol Complex Restoration and Beautification Commission this past April for the placement of a POW/MIA display on the second floor, west wing of the Capitol in Pierre. Foster stressed the need to educate the public that many prisoners of war were left behind. He noted that South Dakota has 24 Prisoners of War and 357 heroes still missing in action.

Rolling Thunder presented their design for the project to the Commission and with their unanimous support, hopes to have it completed in time for dedication on POW/MIA Day, Sept. 17.

The display will include the United States, the South Dakota and the POW/MIA flags, as well as the symbolic empty chair serving as a memorial to those who served in the military but who did not return to us.
