

RCS REOPENING -- FALL 2020

As we all are aware, these are unprecedented times, and plans are subject to change at any moment. However, at the present time, the following is a brief overview of our plan for reopening. We will have a page on our website with more details and FAQs. Additional information / individual questions will be addressed at upcoming open houses or by contacting RCS administration. **It is imperative that everyone follow the safety protocols and guidance from the state, CDC, DHHS, and RCS.**

Plan B -- 50% attendance/capacity

Parents will have the option of remote-learning only for their children. Those who choose remote-only will be required to do so for that six-week period. They may then reassess the situation to see if they prefer face-to-face instruction. Those who choose remote-only learning for a second six weeks will be required to do so for the remainder of the semester.

Classroom capacity -- with 50 percent of students on campus, RCS will maintain six-foot social distancing in classrooms for face-to-face instruction. **All students and staff will be required to wear a mask all day, except when eating lunch.** If a student has a legitimate medical reason for not wearing a mask -- with proper medical documentation -- administration will meet with the parents to discuss options.

Monday and Tuesday -- one-half of middle school students and one-half of high school students will be on campus. The other 50 percent will follow their daily schedule at home, as teachers simulcast from classrooms. Custodians will clean and sanitize throughout the day. Students will use hand sanitizer as they enter each classroom.

Wednesday -- All instruction will be remote. Custodians will deep clean the building.

Thursday and Friday -- the one-half of middle and high school students who were not on campus Monday and Tuesday will be in the building, and the other half will follow their schedule from home, as teachers simulcast. Students will use hand sanitizer as they enter each classroom. Custodians will clean throughout the day.

Saturday -- Custodians will deep clean and sanitize the building.

Daily illness screenings will be conducted on all students, staff and anyone entering the building, including temperature checks prior to entering the building. More detailed information about daily illness screenings will be on the RCS reopening page --

All instructional resources will be housed on Canvas for both face-to-face and remote learning. Teachers will take attendance for both in-person and remote learning students, and students will be required to follow their daily schedule and participate in learning activities for both remote and in-person classes. **All learning activities and assignments will count toward a students' final grade, whether in-person or remote.**

Teachers will share their daily office hours with students and parents.
