

RCS - 2021 Fall Opening

- No restrictions per Dave Machado (N.C. Director of the Office of Charter Schools) with the exception of:
 - RCS will require masks of all students, staff, and visitors
 - This policy will be reviewed, reassessed, and voted on by the board each month throughout the school year.
- RCS will continue temperature checks for students and staff.
 - Even though the temperature check requirement was waived by Governor Cooper in April, 2021, we feel this is a good practice and may be an incentive to parents to monitor their student's health before coming to school.
- Classrooms will return to normal
 - Still require all students to use hand sanitizer before entering the classroom.
 - Continue to clean desk and chair surfaces after each class.
- Hallways will return to normal traffic patterns
 - 7th and 8th grade hallway will stay the same (one way traffic)
- Lunch
 - 6th grade students continue to eat in classrooms/outside.
 - 6th grade students will pick up their lunches from the Dining Hall and return to their classrooms or go outside for lunch.
 - Grades 7-12 may eat in the Dining Halls, their classrooms, and/or outside.
 - Upperclassmen will be allowed to leave campus for lunch.
 - No salad bar.
 - Salads can be ordered and made by the Dining Hall staff like we did this past year.
 - Baked potatoes will be available.
 - Potatoes will be prepared by the Dining Hall staff.
 - Toppings will be provided in individual containers.
 - Students will be allowed to use the microwave ovens this year.
