Chireno ISD Inclement Weather/Emergency Procedures

On occasion, inclement weather or some type of other emergency will affect the district's day-to-day operations. Should these instances occur, the Superintendent may close or delay the start of school. The district's transportation director and/or the maintenance foreman along with other assigned personnel will report on road conditions within the district and make a recommendation to the Superintendent regarding possible travel hazards. Information regarding other emergencies will also be reported to the Superintendent, who will make the decision as to whether:

- A) School will be held as scheduled;
- B) The start of school will be delayed (Usually a 2-hour delay);
- C) School will be canceled.

Chireno ISD will make every effort to inform parents and employees of school closures or delays in a timely and effective manner. If the decision is made to close or delay school, the district will notify parents and employees through our Apptegy Alert call out system, the district's website (www.chirenoisd.org), and through Facebook.

Information regarding the closing or delaying of school will be given to our local radio stations (KYKS 105.1 fm, KTBQ 107.7 fm, KJCS 103.3 fm, KQBB 100.5 fm, and KSWB 90.1 fm) as well as our local TV stations (KLTV, KTRE, and KETK).
